

FRESH AGAIN® STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS from Satin Stitches® Ltd.

- ♥ FRESH AGAIN® does NOT work instantly, nor does it add a fragrance. It works by the act of drying. After you spray it on your garment or shoes, you must allow the item to thoroughly dry (at least overnight).
- ♥ FRESH AGAIN® is safe to use on specialty fabrics and trims. If you have any doubt, we recommend testing on a fabric or trim swatch, or on a small, unnoticed area of any costume or uniform, first. We have tested this product on all of the fabrics and trims that we use. FRESH AGAIN® is a water-based product, so if your fabric will not react adversely to water, it will be safe with FRESH AGAIN®
- ♥ Turn your garment inside out or unzip to expose the inside. For shoes or dance bags etc. - simply spray inside.
- ♥ Remove the cap from your spray bottle and generously spray the "stinky" areas on the INSIDE of your garment. We do not recommend spraying on the outside. The spray works on the odor molecules that are on the inside of the garment. (The most "stinky" areas of a garment include the armpits, back, neck and crotch.) Spray in a flowing manner from area to area. Example: when we spray one armpit, and move to the other, we spray once in the middle bodice area. Spray enough to dampen the garment, holding the spray bottle within a few inches so the spray reaches the fabric. There is a slight chemical odor - but this goes away when it dries on the garment or shoes.
- ♥ You may notice that the fabrics in the sprayed areas look darker. This is just because the fabric is wet. The color difference should go away once your garment is dry.
- ♥ Let your garment completely air dry (at least overnight) before storing. (We treated a rack of 35 VERY "stinky", fully sequined jackets - liberally with FRESH AGAIN® on a Friday afternoon, letting them air dry over the weekend. On Monday morning the "stink" was gone! Do NOT ever dry costumes or uniforms in the sun.
- ♥ For best results, spray right after each and every performance, but this is not necessary. If your costumes or uniforms start to "stink" - this is the best time to treat them! Some groups do this twice per season, some more often.
- ♥ Dry-cleaning can actually set in the smell, instead of removing it. It is best to treat your garments BEFORE you send them to the dry-cleaners. Dry-cleaners now do not generally apply a deodorizer to your garments any more, as these chemicals can cause allergic reactions. FRESH AGAIN® does not have a history of ANY reported allergic reactions. This product has been in use since the 70's by the military, police and fire departments, along with movie and theatrical productions. It is just new to the retail dance, band and entertainment market.
- ♥ FRESH AGAIN® will still work after garments have been dry-cleaned. They just may need more treatments, or more liberal spraying. You also may need to use multiple applications to old, very "stinky" uniforms that have been worn many years without treatment.
- ♥ We always recommend wearing tight, white cotton T-shirts and underwear under your costumes and uniforms to absorb some of the body's perspiration.
- ♥ By using FRESH AGAIN® when your costumes and uniforms are only "stinky", but not stained or dirty, you will save money on laundering services and you will prolong the life of these garment two ways. First of all, the fibers of the fabrics will not break down from odor and perspiration nearly as fast, and second of all - the actual laundering procedures will not be needed. Water washing or dry-cleaning can ruin today's specialty fabrics which include surface prints and glitzy trims. By not having to launder your costumes and uniforms to keep them fresh, they will last longer, retaining their "brand new" integrity!
- ♥ Also save money by ordering the large, gallon sized container that doesn't have the spray nozzle, but use it to refill your smaller spray bottles.
